As you will be aware a School Streets scheme has been in place around a school near where you live or work. The aim of the School Streets is to reduce traffic around schools in order to create a calmer, more pleasant environment for pupils, parents and residents, a space with less air pollution and that will encourage more pupils and parents to walk, scoot and cycle on the school journey.

Planters have been put in place to define the extents of the School Streets. Residents and businesses, including access for delivery vehicles, is permitted as normal, however access for parents to drop off and pick up is not allowed.
