### PE:

This term we will be continuing our ball skills as well as participating in some simple games. We will be looking at how rules can control the games we play and continue working on playing as a team.

#### Science:

This term we will be studying humans and animals. We will be exploring the features of humans and animals, including the senses. We will begin to classify animals into groups and look at the differences in their diets. We will also study the life cycles of humans and animals and compare the differences between them.

## Desing and technology:

Children will create fruit kebabs, practising new skills with a range of tools and equipment to perform cutting motions. Children will select from a range of fruits, build and evaluate our kebabs. Understnading what was difficult and what was easy in the process.

# Computing

The children will be learning to create and use algorithms to programme robots to achieve a task. They will learn to create and sequence instructions carefully and check for errors in their programming. The pupils will create their own beebot maps and then create instructions to guide their robot around them.

# **History & Geography**

The children will be looking at the seaside resort of Blackpool and how it has changed over time. They will make comparisons between holidays now and those of the past. We will be looking at the key physical and human geographical features of Balckpool and compare it with another location inside Europe.

## R.E:

This term the children will be looking at two topics in RE, Oppertunties and Spread the word. We will be revisting our Lent promises and spreading good news amongst each other. Children will complete a range of activities from prayer writing to renacting Bible stories.

## **Opportunities**

The children will explore and understand the oppertunties that Jesus had in his life. We reflect on how Jesus fasted for 40 days, was crucified and how he resurrected. Pupils will gain an understanding of how sacrificing our own needs can be helpful for helping our friends and families.

## Spread the word

Children will know and understand the passing of messages good or bad. Spreading the Gospel message through the gift of the Holy Spirit and aquire the skills of assimilation, celebration and application of spreading news.

#### Maths:

In Maths, we will be working on place value of numbers up to 50 and using these to solve addition and subtraction calculations. We will be expanding our understanding of length, height, weight and volume and using a variety of equipment to support our learning in these areas. We will move on to multiplication and division and work on fractions later in the term.

#### English:

The children will be looking at a range of writing genres this term. We will be studying traditional tales from Australia, writing explanation texts and letters and creating our own works of fiction.

We will be looking to improve our writing using adjectives and conjunctions, beginning to look at tenses and using a range of punctuation including capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks.

We will also be looking to find information in texts and use it to answer questions, make predictions and simple inferences about why things happened.

#### Art:

In our Art lessons we will be continuing developing our skills in using different techniques to create pattern and texture. We will be exploring this through Printing, using various methods to create different effects. We will also be looking at works done by different artists who also use Printing in their artwork.

## **PSHE:**

Our PSHE lessons this term will be focused on the core theme of Created to Love Others. The children will be engaging in lessons based around three topics: religious Understanding, Personal Relationships and Keeping Safe.
