If your child is unwell with a sickness bug, please remember that your child is to remain off school until 48 hours after the last time they were sick or have diarrhoea, this is to prevent them passing on any bugs to other children.

With the recent cases of scarlet fever we would also like to remind parents that if your child develops a rash you will need to seek medical advice before your child is allowed to attend school, this is to prevent contagious illnesses such as chicken pox, measles and scarlet fever from potentially spreading around the school.

We still ensure regular hand washing and deep cleaning of the school to minimise the spread of infections.

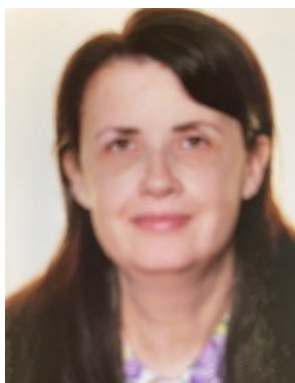

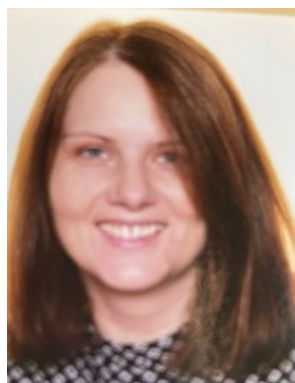
