This half term children will know how to negotiate space successfully when playing racing and chasing games with other children, adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles

Know how to show a preference for a dominant hand.

Know how to develop their small motor skills so that they can use a range of tools competently, safely and confidently.

Communication and Language:

This half term children will know and understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important.

Know how to engage in story times.

Know how to be able to explore new vocabulary, sounds and intonation.

Know how to play alongside other children engaged in the same type of imaginary play.

Personal, Social and Emotional:

This half term children will know how to welcome and value praise for what they have done.

Know how to willingly participate in a wide range of activities.

Know how to start conversations, attend to and take account of what others say.

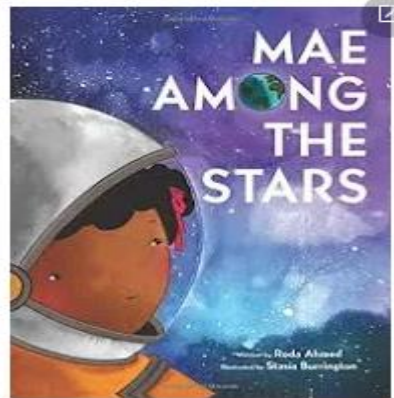
Understanding the world:

This half term children will know how to recognise and describe special times or events for family or friends.

Know how to talk about why things happen and how things work.

Religious Education:

This half term children will know and understand what a celebration is.

Know and understand how the parish family celebrate.

Know and acquire the skills of assimilation, celebration and application of the above.

We will also be learning about Chinese New Year, a Hindu-Buddhist celebration as part of our alternative faith learning.

The children will visit St Augustine's Catholic Church to learn how the parish family celebrates.

Mathematics:

This half term children will know how to approach addition and find the total number of items in two groups by counting all of them and starting to use 'counting on'.

Know numerals and be able to represent them for 1 to 5, then 1 to 10 objects. Then 1 – 20.

Know how to begin to use 'teens' to count beyond 10.

Know how to count an irregular arrangement of up to ten objects.

Literacy:

This half term children will know how to form lower-case and capital letters correctly.

Know how to spell words by identifying all the sounds and then writing the sound with letter/s.

Know how to use vocabulary and events from stories in my play.

Know how to make suggestions about what might happen next in a story.

Expressive arts and Design:

This half term children will know how to create collaboratively sharing ideas, resources and skills.

Know how to develop preferences for forms of expression.

Know how to use movement to express feelings.

Know how to create movement in response to music.

Characteristics of Effective Learning:
