Please can we ask that parents do not send their child to school with nut products.

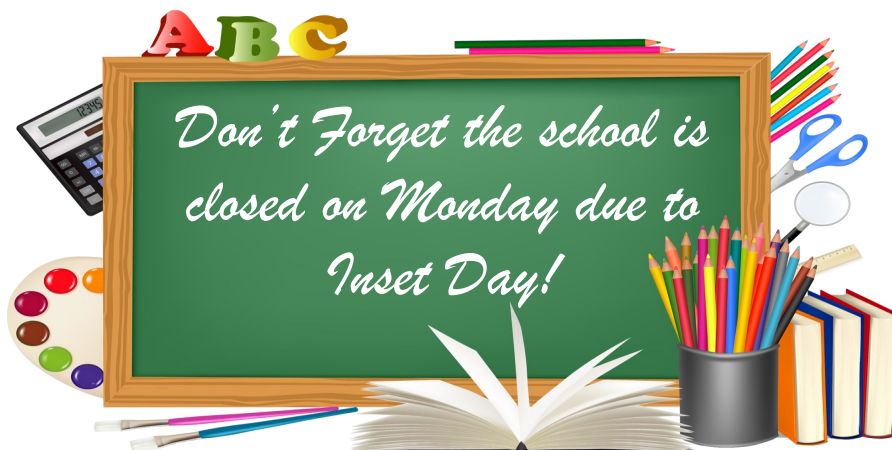
This includes Nutella, Peanut butter, Pistachio nuts and Muesli Bars.

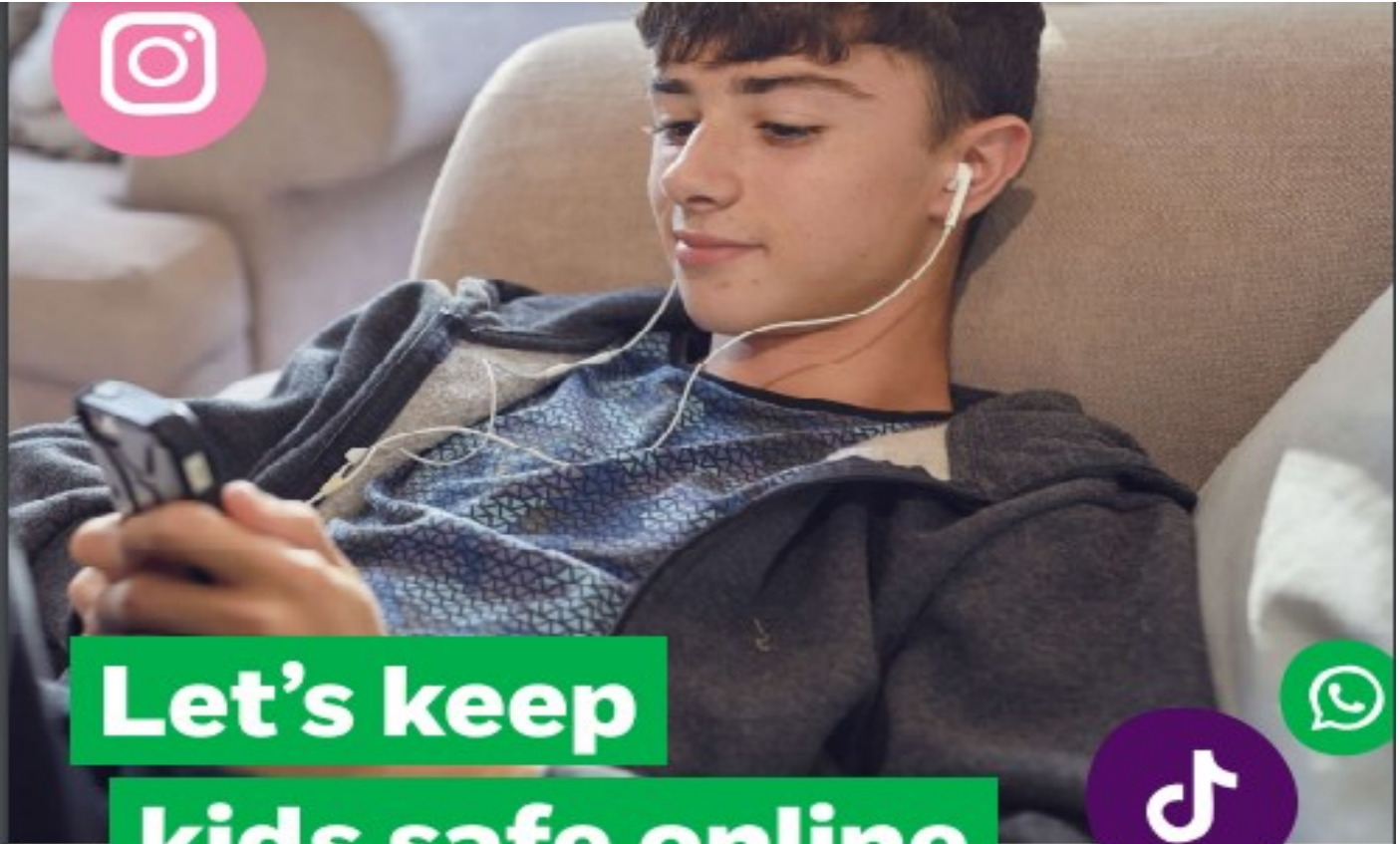
