Hello – welcome back to our Curriculum Corner for the second week of Pentecost 2! We have had such a fun and busy week, as always!



We finished our work on 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' in English, including a very positive book review from everyone in Poppies and Daisies!

Ask me:

Why did I like this story? What was my favourite part and why?

In Maths we have been recapping our Shape, Space and Measure learning! We are exploring concepts such as: weight, length, height, width. We went around the classroom and used rulers to compare the size of things.

Ask me:

Can you measure some things around your house? What is the longest thing, what is the shortest?



In our Catholic Social Teaching session this week we explored 'Stewardship'. On Tuesday we looked at how we can help look after the planet, more precisely, our school.
