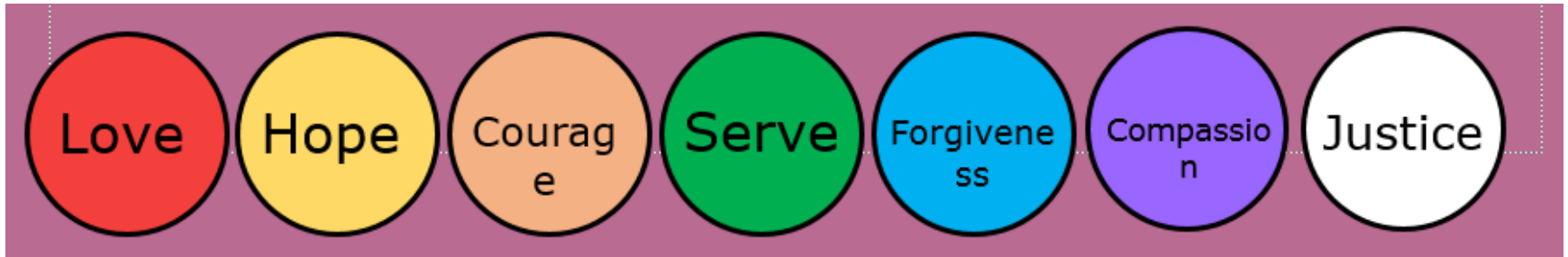

- Read whatever captures and inspires them!
- Read a mix of fiction/non-fiction if possible
- Read to them too!
- Record in planner
- Read 5 x a week at least- tick box- Dojos
- Library books
- **WHOLE CLASS READING** based on a novel and reading comprehension work
