

Physical Development:

This half term, the children will know how to crawl, jump, hop and skip. They will know how to use climbing equipment and balance confidently.

Know how to use a tripod grasp.

Know how to develop their overall body strength, co-ordination, balance and agility needed to engage successfully with future physical education sessions.

Communication and Language:

This half term, the children will know how to ask questions about their favourite book. Ask questions to find out more and check understanding.

Know how to play alongside other children engaged in the same type of imaginary play.

Know how to be able to explore new vocabulary, sounds and intonation.

Personal, Social and Emotional:

This term, the children will know how to explain their own knowledge and understanding, and ask appropriate questions of others.

Know how to be confident to speak to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions.

Know how to start conversations, attend to and take account of what others say

Understanding the world:

This term, the children will know how to recognise and describe special times or events for family or friends.

Know how to describe what they see, hear and feel whilst outside.

Know how to talk about why things happen and how things work.

English:

This term, the children will know how to say a sound for each letter in the alphabet. They will know how to spell words by identifying all the sounds and then writing the sound with letter/s. They will begin to learn 'Phase 3' sounds which are our vowel digraphs and trigraphs.

They will now how to use vocabulary and events from stories in play and know how to form lower-case and capital letters correctly.

Mathematics:

This term, children will know to subitise from 0-5. They will know how to recognise zero and understand the meaning of zero.

Know what balance means and how to balance objects.

Know the meaning of mass and be able to use words such as heavier and lighter to describe an object.

Know how to pair odd and even numbers.

Religious Education:

This term our R.E topic will focus on celebration and gathering. The children will know what a parish family is and how they celebrate. They will know the presentation story and why Jesus was taken to the temple. The children will know that the parish family gathers for Mass.

They will be remembering, celebrating and responding to how and why people gather together and the joy of gathering together to celebrate at Mass.
