History:

Music:

Pentecost 1 – Inter-Related Dimension of Music (Melody) The children will understand and perform layered, melodic ostinato patterns. By the end of the year they will be able to read new notes from stave notation and be able to incorporate the ostinato/layering sections within the middle of piece before performing and evaluating their performance.

Pentecost 2 – Compose: By the end of this year the children will be composing short pentatonic phrases and notate these onto a stave. They will be able to perform their pentatonic pieces and a song with musicianship, being able to listen and appraise their performances.
