Opening Days & Times	8.45-3.30pm
Weeks open in Year	38 weeks – term time only, aligned with the calendar of the school.
Available sessions	8.45-11.45 - Nursery 12.30-15.30 - Nursery HA4K – Wraparound Care 7.30am-8.45am 3.20pm-5.45pm
Age range	From 3 rd Birthday up to school age.

Early Education Funding Offer & Delivery Patterns

Up to 15 hours of government funded childcare is available to all three and four years old in England from the term after their third birthday.

The government call this universal funded childcare as it is available to all three- and four-year-olds. It is available up to 15 hours per week over 38 weeks. Families could stretch the funding further over the year, by using fewer hours per week¹. The maximum hours available for universal funding is 570 hours per year.

If you live and work in England you may be entitled to 30 hours funded childcare support for your child, until they start school.

Charges for additional Hours

Parents may require their child to stay for additional hours beyond the funding offer and where space is available, we will strive to accommodate this.

Charges for Additional Hours	
Where families require hours over and above their daily funded entitlement (3 or 6 hours), charges will be applied as follows in multiples of ½ hours:	3- and 4-Year-olds £3.00 per ½ hour

Charges for optional services

We charge for some optional services, including meals and extra activities; Parents and Carers should note that these services are optional and will only be charged if you request them. Families are welcome to provide their own alternatives.
